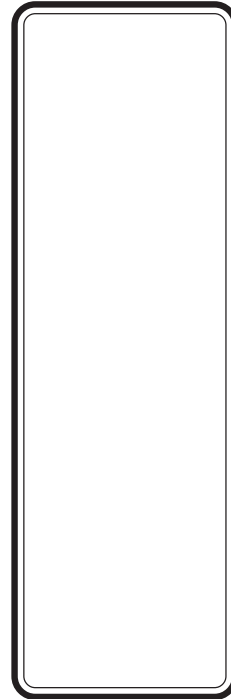
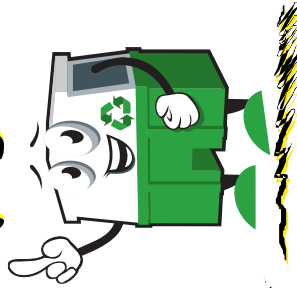

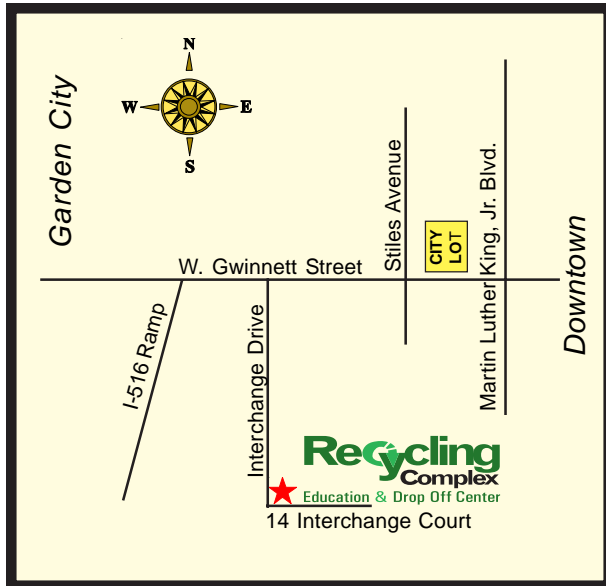

Our Mission

The mission of the Recycling Complex is to provide a venue for collecting recyclables, and to educate the public regarding the importance of waste reduction, conservation of natural resources, reducing landfill space through a series of tours, school classroom visits, videos, and educational literature.



Facility Capacity

Specialized compartmental recycling containers, open top 40-yard roll-off containers, and eight-yard containers are housed at the Recycling Complex to accommodate the collection of recyclables. When these containers are filled they are transported to a private contractor for processing.

Recyclables Accepted

Recyclables are accepted at the Recycling Complex in nine streams – aluminum, steel, plastic (commingled #1 and #2), scrap metals, white goods, corrugated cardboard, magazines, newspaper, and mixed paper. All recyclables should be emptied, rinsed and/or cleaned accordingly prior to deposit. Here are a few examples of various acceptable items:

Steel



- ◆ Cans and containers.
- ◆ Empty aerosol cans with tops removed.
- ◆ Various steel products such as pipes, drums, etc.

Plastics (#1 & #2)



- ◆ Bottles and jugs marked either #1 such as soda, water, cooking oil bottles, or #2 such as detergent bottles or milk jugs with tops and labels removed.
- ◆ No plastic bags are accepted.

Scrap Metals



- ◆ Bicycle parts, swing sets.
- ◆ Metal shelving, wiring, fencing.
- ◆ Various metal and alloy products and scrap material (all plastic parts removed).

Newspaper



- ◆ Include inserts.

Magazines



- ◆ No plastic packaging please.

White Goods



- ◆ Various appliances (all colors) such as washers, dryers, refrigerators, stoves, hot water heaters, etc.

Mixed Paper (various fiber grades)



- ◆ Assorted paper such as telephone directories, office paper, cereal boxes without the liners, beer & soda cartons, junk mail, etc.
- ◆ No wax coated paper accepted.

Cardboard



- ◆ Corrugated cardboard boxes identified by a waffle core sandwiched between flat inner and outer liner paper.
- ◆ Please flatten and fold.
- ◆ No wax coated boxes accepted.

Aluminum



- ◆ Soda cans.
- ◆ Beer cans.
